

Make Your Own Jump Rope



I've turned the handles, you make the rest. First we cut 3 pieces of jute and wrap them on the ends of "The Cranky Thing".



It's good to have plenty of help. Someone needs to turn "The Cranky Thing" while someone else holds the twines and keeps them from tangling.

You turn and turn and turn "The Cranky Thing" until the twines just begin to kink. Then you unhook it all and a rope appears almost as if by magic as you wind it the opposite way. The cost is \$8 each.
